


VISIBLE SKY

Evening Planets: Venus will be visible in the west just after sunset throughout the month of May. Views of Jupiter in the southeast will get better as the month goes on. By the end of May Jupiter will be rising before sunset and will be high enough to clear most tree lines by the time it gets dark.

Morning Planets: Saturn and Mars continue to be visible in the south morning sky throughout the month of May. Jupiter will be visible in the southwest for much of the month as well, but in the final week will begin setting as early as 5 A.M.
